Seminar 3: Current Tax Issues for Charities

This session will serve as an introduction or refresher of the tax benefits and tax rules for charitable institutions (using the traditional legal definition which includes "the relief of poverty or sickness or the needs of the aged, the advancement of education, the advancement of religion, and other purposes beneficial to the community"). The session will also consider current issues including:

- DGR status (gift deductibility for donors and FBT benefits)
- Income tax exemption
- Qualifying for and keeping the tax benefits
- Challenging ATO decisions
- Effect of commercial and lobbying activities
- Useful ATO resources
